### 2027 Membership Application

To start the certification process, you will need to complete the following.

1. **Submit your completed application and your check for \$125 to cover fees.**
2. **Complete an online new Master Gardener orientation.**
3. **Submit and pass a background check.**

Once these are done, you may begin your required education and volunteer commitment. These are to be completed by September of the year following your classroom instruction.

Certification classes and field trips will generally be held in Llano on Tuesdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for 11 weeks. Classes begin February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2027 and end April 13, 2027.

1. **50 hours of horticulture education**, most of which are provided in classroom instruction and field trips. The rest can be completed at monthly MG meetings and/or watching/reading Aggie horticulture videos and articles.
2. **50 hours of volunteering** can include public garden maintenance, serving committees, assisting at MG events, like the semi-annual Native Plant Sale.
